#### Port Arthur and the Tasman Peninsula

The World Heritage Port Arthur Historic Site is a very popular holiday destination with visitors coming from all over the world to see what remains of this British penal colony. As the site contains a museum, numerous historic buildings and ruins, the entry fee to the Site provides a two day pass which also includes a guided tour and a harbour cruise around the Isle of the Dead. Each night when darkness descends eerily on the Historic Site you can join the lantern-lit Ghost tour, which is particularly intriguing for children.

The <u>Tasman Peninsula</u> is an extraordinary destination for scenery, walks, beaches and fishing, particularly when tuna are running. In the Tasman National Park there are numerous short walks to stunning coastal scenery, such as the Coal Mines Historic Site, Tessellated Pavement, Remarkable Cave and Blow Hole, Tasman Arch, Devil's Kitchen & Patersons Arch coastal walks. For the physically fit there are world class walks to Cape Raoul, Cape Hauy and Cape Pillar. If sea conditions permit the half day Tasman Island Cruise is not to be missed.

Burilda Waters is situated on Big Possum Beach with views of Carnarvon Bay. The location is central to the numerous attractions that are located on the <u>Tasman Peninsula</u> and the Port Arthur Historic Site is only five minutes away by car. If you prefer to walk there is a coastal track that starts at the northerly end of the bay. For those who appreciate the outdoor environment, a prolonged visit would be required to explore this region with its inspirational coastal walks and spectacular views.

Burilda Waters is a self contained cottage providing spacious accommodation with views of Carnarvon Bay and the Isle of the Dead. The upstairs main bedroom with ensuite sleeps two in a queen size bed. There is a second lounge area, two bedrooms a bathroom and toilet downstairs. The ocean view bedroom has a queen size bed and the other bedroom a single bed.

It is so relaxing to sit back in the upstairs lounge/dining room or the balcony and savour the ever changing moods of Carnarvon Bay with the boats and yachts anchored there. Usually you will see black swans, ducks, terns and cormorants feeding and if you are lucky the occasional cruise ship. Whilst you are enjoying the panoramic views you can watch a DVD on the flat screen television, or listen to a compact disc on the hi-fi system. In the cooler months it is a pleasure just to sit in front of the wood fire and savour the view.

A general store and a bottle shop are located on the Nubeena Road 10km away, just before the White Beach turn off. A bakery with take away food is located at Nubeena. For extended holidays it would be prudent to shop in Sorell as local supermarkets may not have your favourite products. There are bars at the Port Arthur Motor Inn and at the Fox and Hounds.

Burilda Waters is located at Port Arthur on the Tasman Peninsula, Tasmania, Australia.

If you are travelling from Hobart you should allow 1.5 hours, or one hour from the Hobart airport. The scenic drive is part of the Convict Trail Touring Route passing through some lovely villages and past a number of bays.

If time allows we recommend that you break your journey by stopping off at the Copping Museum where you can have a look at their collection of unique colonial exhibits and view the gallery of gifts produced by local artisans. Coffee and light refreshments are served and local wines and produce are also available.

We also recommend a short diversion to the Pirates Bay Lookout. Turn left off the Tasman Highway at the top of the hill two kilometers before Eaglehawk Neck down Pirates Bay Drive. Signpost: Tasman Sea Cliff Coast.

# Directions to Burilda Waters Waterfront Holiday House on the Tasman Peninsula

- Follow the Arthur Highway to Port Arthur.
- 600 meters past the turn off to the Port Arthur Historic Site, turn left down Safety Cove road (Signpost Remarkable Cave).
- Burilda Waters is located on the right 1.80 km from the turn off.
