## **Team of the Year**

Introduced in 2014 the Team of the Year is a 10 player squad of players selected through a nomination process where each A grade coach is requested to nominate 'the best' 3 players in each area of the court. From this list an honorary team of 7 starters and 3 bench players are selected.

#### **Best and Fairest**

Best and Fairest medals are awarded in all other grades as voted by the team officials at each match during the Season.
