Education

Apprenticeship

Licensing

Most states require electricians to obtain a license to practice, although specific regulations vary. To earn a license, electricians usually need a minimum amount of work experience, and they must pass an exam.

Balance, hand-eye coordination and physical fitness are important as well, because electricians work long hours on construction sites and with live wires.
