The state-of-the-art purpose built facilities provide the latest in technology, patient comfort and safety, on-demand entertainment and work place safety. The clinic incorporates 6 modern dental clinics including one operating theatre with general anaesthetic facilities, a recovery room and sterilisation areas with the latest equipment. Staff areas and waiting rooms complete the clinical areas, along with a sophisticated board room facility providing a training venue for visiting dental clinicians.

By cooperating with Nobel Biocare and Dr Paulo Malo's Malo Clinic, we are one of the Australian leaders where the All-On-4 dental implant technique is concerned. All-On-4 is an alternative for regular dental implants, because the treatment could eliminate bone grafting in patients who are lacking the jawbone for regular dental implants. The All-On-4 technique only requires four to six dental implants too, so the treatment can usually be executed quicker than a regular dental implant treatment. All You Need to Know About the Bond Street Dental Clinic

The Bond Street Dental team prides itself on the services they provide to patients. When a patient walks through the doors of our surgery, it is our aim to make that patient as comfortable as possible and provide him with the services he deserves. If you want to get more familiar with some of the services we offer, please read our information below.

Teeth Whitening Services

Patients can make an appointment at the Bond Street Dental Clinic to get their teeth whitened. Our trained dental hygienist uses the professional teeth whitening system Zoom, which enables patients to get their teeth whitened in an hour. It is a safe, effective and affordable way to get rid of stains and make your teeth a little lighter, so many patients use this service to improve the aesthetics of the teeth.

The Bond Street Dental Clinic can also prepare a home whitening kit for patients who do not have the time for an appointment, but still need a professional teeth whitening service. Each home whitening kit is made for each individual patient; this makes sure that the accompanying mouthguard protects their gums properly against the chemicals in the whitening gel. Porcelain Crowns and Veneers

Porcelain crowns and veneers are commonly used to improve the aesthetics of a patient's teeth, but also to make the teeth stronger and protect the natural teeth that are underneath. Even though there are various materials available for dental crowns and veneers, the Bond Street Dental Clinic mainly uses porcelain. Porcelain is an excellent material for dental restorations, since this material blends perfectly with the natural teeth. Porcelain is also strong, so it can take strong impacts such as chewing and biting.

Porcelain crowns and veneers are bonded to the natural teeth of the patient; this also means that a little bit of the natural teeth needs to be removed to execute the bonding process. Since dentists aim to maintain as much of the natural teeth as possible, the procedure will only be executed when the tooth is susceptible to more decay or structural failure.

Cosmetic Analysis

The cosmetic analysis is an appointment where the dentist evaluates your overall general health and creates a treatment plan to improve the aesthetics of the teeth. The treatment plan can include treatments such as veneers, crowns, dental implants, orthodontics and more, so this appointment is ideal for patients who want to improve the appearance of their teeth, but have no idea which treatments are available to them.

Smile Enhancements

Our smile enhancements include all treatments that could improve the smile of a patient. Therefore, you will need a smile enhancement appointment when you need a solution for discoloured teeth, chipped teeth, missing teeth, crowded teeth, gum disease and more.

Oral Health

Sometimes your teeth need a professional clean, or you need additional advice on your oral hygiene products. If this applies to you, you'll need an oral health appointment at our clinic, which is basically an appointment with our dental hygienist.

The dental hygienist can do more than provide you with a professional teeth cleaning and some recommendations for dental hygiene products, they can also provide solutions for problems such as halitosis or bad breath. Together with your dental hygienist, you can determine the cause of your bad breath and receive a viable treatment plan.

Dental Implants

When a patient misses a tooth or several teeth, there are some permanent solutions they can take advantage of. One of the permanent treatments available for missing teeth is the dental implant treatment. During such a treatment, an oral surgeon inserts dental implants into the jawbone of the patient. These dental implants fuse with the jawbone and carry the replacement teeth with abutments. Therefore, dental implants look like natural teeth.

The Bond Street Dental Clinic does not only offer normal dental implant treatments, they also offer the All-On-4 dental implant treatment. The All-On-4 dental implant treatment is executed by inserting four dental implants into the jaw of the patient. These four dental implants carry an entire arch of teeth, so it is only a solution for people with several missing teeth.

General Dentistry

Patients can visit the Bond Street Dental Clinic for their regular check-ups and dental hygienist visits; this also includes general dentistry services such as tooth-coloured fillings, CEREC porcelain teeth, wisdom teeth removal, preventative dentistry, snoring solutions, root canal treatments, teeth grinding, custom-made mouthguards and much more.

Sleep Dentistry & Services for Anxious Patients

We understand that some patients can feel quite anxious about their visit to the dentist or the dental hygienist. Even though there is nothing to be afraid of, there are many people who experience a fear of the dentist nonetheless. Our aim is to make every patient comfortable, so we also cater to patients who experience anxiety when they should visit the dentist.

Some patients even cancel their appointments just before their visit, since they experience too much anxiety to even enter our clinic. If you experience such anxiety, but are really in need of an appointment with the dentist, it could be an idea to contact our dental clinic beforehand and visit our facilities before your appointment. By visiting us, you can get more familiar with the environment and our staff, so your second visit will be easier.
